OVERVIEW

All Kids is Illinois' program for children who need comprehensive, affordable health insurance, regardless of immigration status or health condition. Services include: doctor visits, hospital stays, prescription drugs, vision care, dental care and eyeglasses. All Kids also covers special services like medical equipment, speech therapy and physical therapy for children who need them.

WHO IS SERVED?

Population(s)/Age Group:

Children ages 0-18

Eligibility Criteria and Screening Tools:

Children can get All Kids health insurance if they

- Live in Illinois.
- Are age 18 or younger.

- Meet the All Kids income guidelines (available on the website <http://www.allkids.com/income.html>)

HOW ARE SERVICES DELIVERED?

Local Service System:

IHFS is mandated to work with community groups to conduct outreach and enrollment activities. The state has formed partnerships with the City of Chicago, public libraries, schools, businesses, health care providers, FQHCs, health departments and churches to educate communities about All Kids and FamilyCare and encourage enrollment.

After the application is submitted, All Kids will send a decision letter. If the child qualifies, the family will receive an All Kids member handbook and medical card.

Most enrollees have to pick a health plan and primary care provider for their medical home. The Illinois Client Enrollment Broker will contact clients when it is time to choose a health plan or provider.
