OVERVIEW
Family Planning Program services are provided to enable individuals the information and means to exercise personal choice in determining the number and spacing of their children through the provision of effective family planning medical services, methods and education (including abstinence).
WHO IS SERVED?
<i>Population(s)/Age Group:</i>
The target population is low-income individuals of reproductive age.
<i>Eligibility Criteria and Screening Tools:</i>
Women, Men and adolescents with income below 100% of poverty are not charged for services. A schedule of discounts is required for incomes between 101% and 250% of poverty.
HOW ARE SERVICES DELIVERED?
<i>Local Service System:</i>
Services are accessed at 80 clinic sites operated by 38 delegate agencies which include Health Departments, Planned Parenthood Clinics, Hospital-based Clinics, Federally Qualified Health Centers and other community-based organizations.
