

State Provider Database (DCFS)

Systems Development Initiative

Overview

The Statewide Provider Database (SPD) is an online database initiative led by DCFS. The database strives to collect and update comprehensive information on service agencies and programs throughout the state of Illinois. The SPD was developed to assist caseworkers within public and private agencies in identifying and locating appropriate services for their clients. SPD contains information on services that are open to children and families (DCFS affiliated and not), regardless of whether an agency holds a DCFS contract. SPD is being used by caseworkers and community partners across Illinois.

There are a wide range of programs in the SPD:

- **Mental Health:** Counseling programs that offer a standard set of outpatient behavioral health services along with other types of services
- **Substance Abuse:** Programs focused primarily on treatment of substance abuse and dependence
- **Parenting:** Programs designed to meet the needs of families working on reunification or intact families who are improving parenting skills through training or coaching
- **Domestic Violence:** Programs offering a range of services to help families cope with domestic violence
- **Early Childhood:** Programs focused on interventions for young children, including but not limited to health screenings, developmental assessments, etc. Programs geared for children ages 0-5.
- **Nonclinical:** A variety of after- school or recreational programs, in addition to tutoring, mentoring, or vocational services
